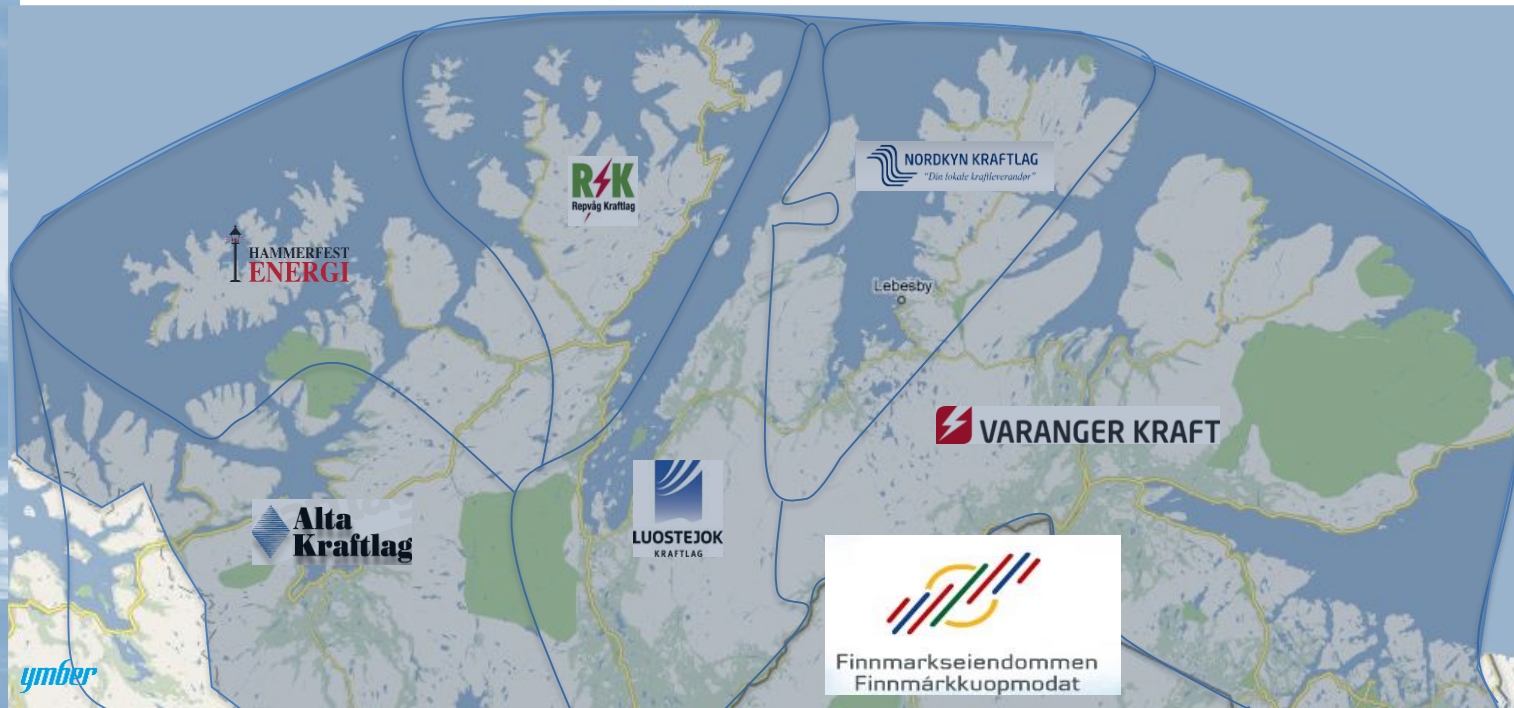

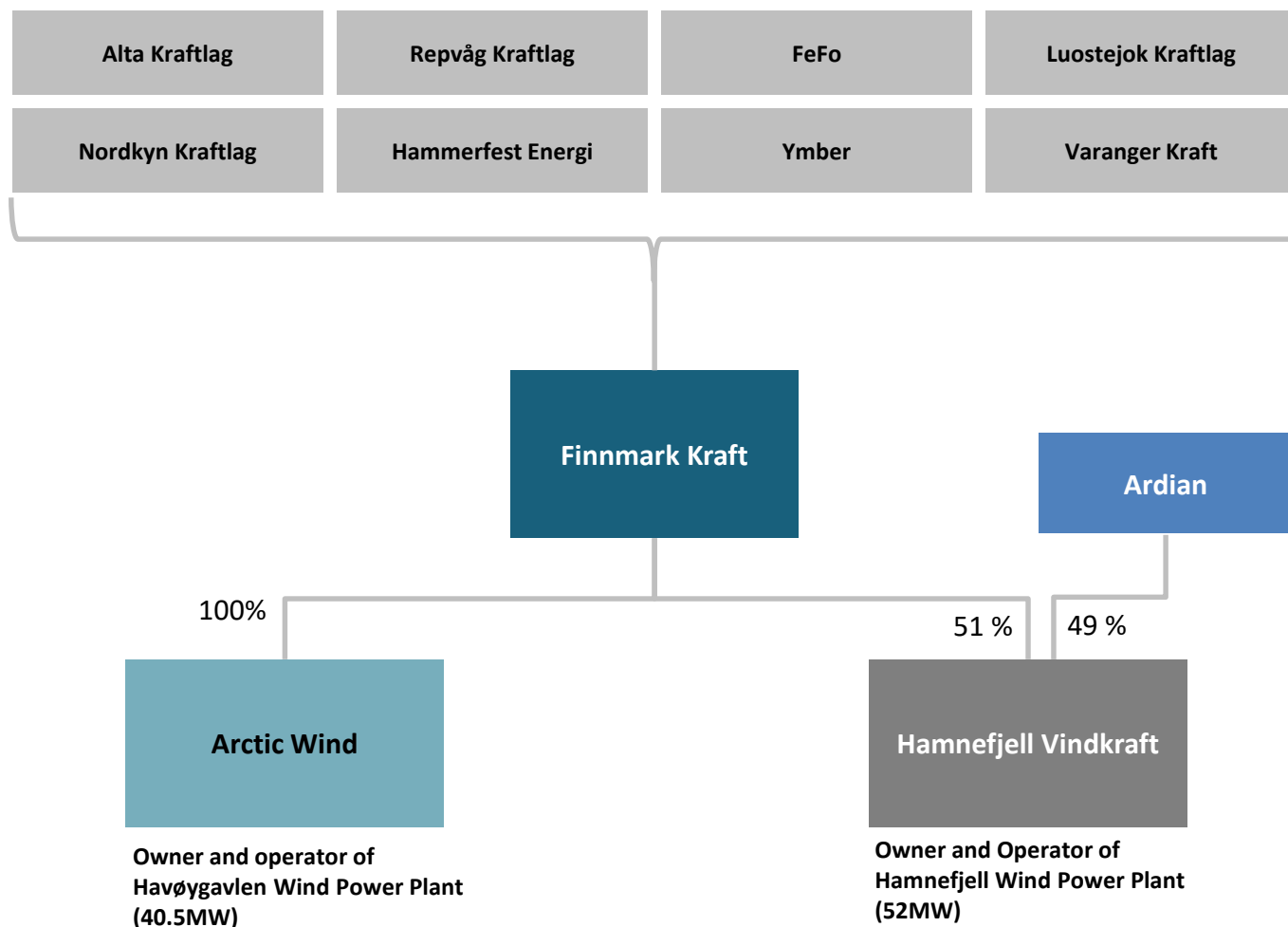

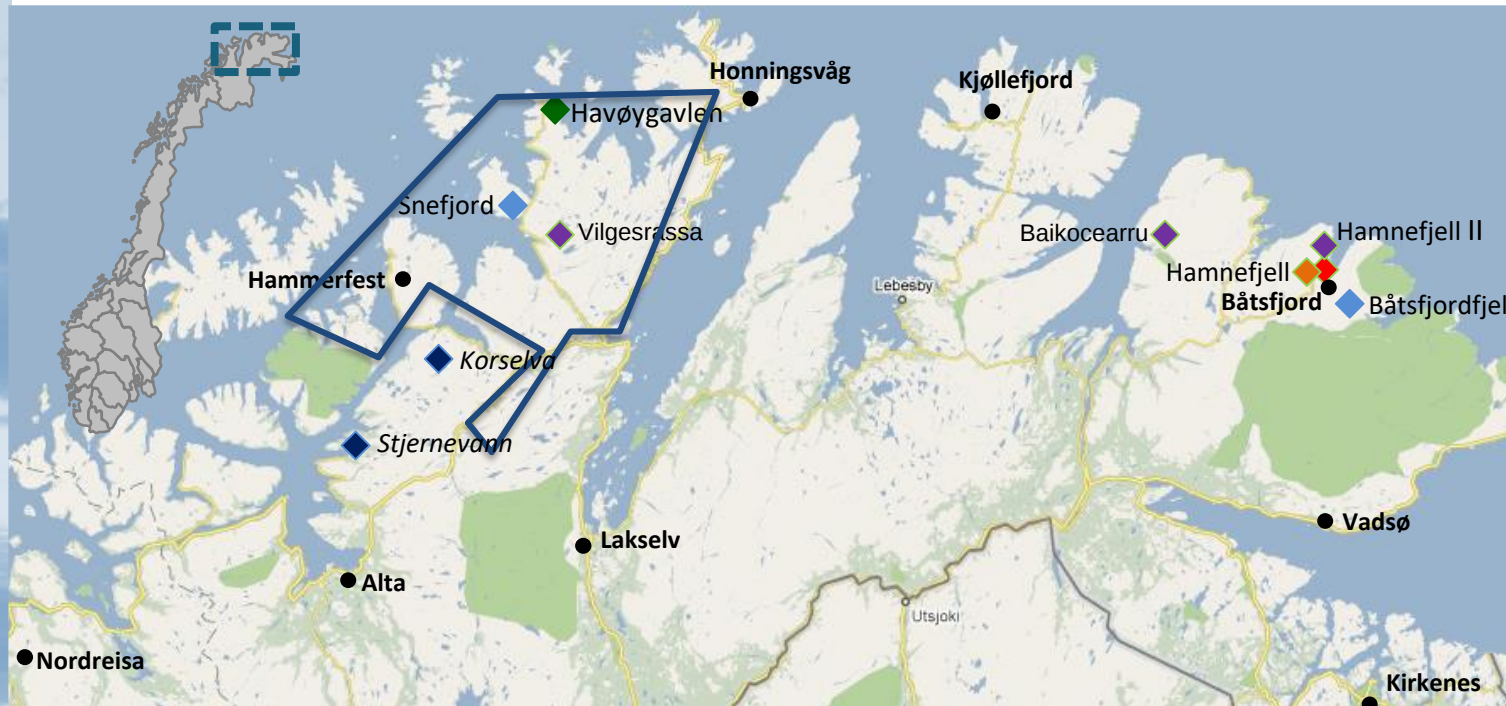

Power Portfolio

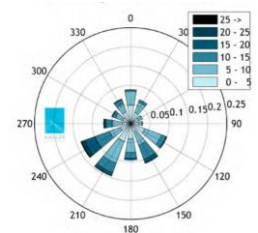

- Landowner Compensation (FeFo)
 - Models based on turnover or production
- Reindeer herding compensation
 - Model based on increased pressure on defined area and increased use of resources for herding
- Municipal property tax
 - Model based on invested capital
- Revenue through ownership
 - All the owners are cooperative -or municipal owned companies
