Expansion of electricity produced with wind energy

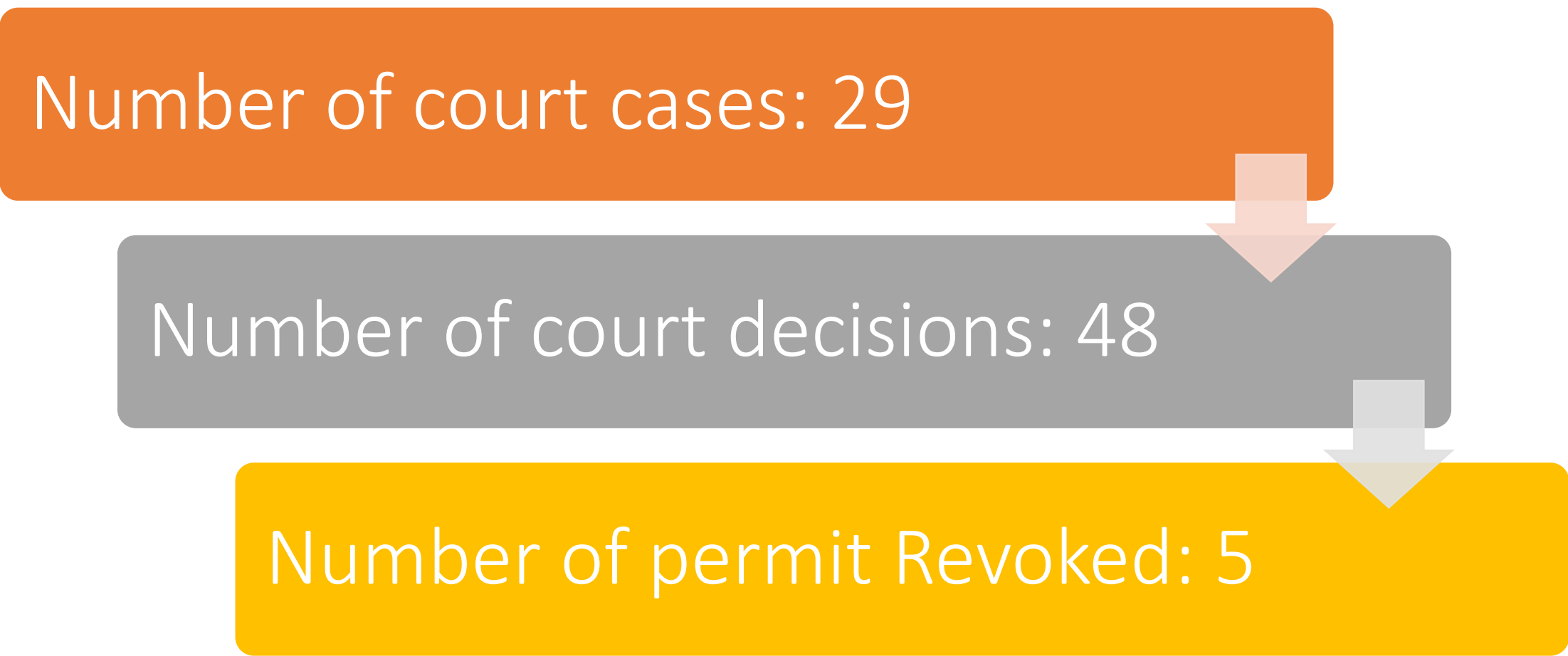
- 2000: 0,4 %
