Special attention is given to water governance, environmental justice, and legal pluralism. Objectives

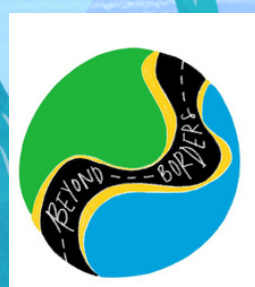

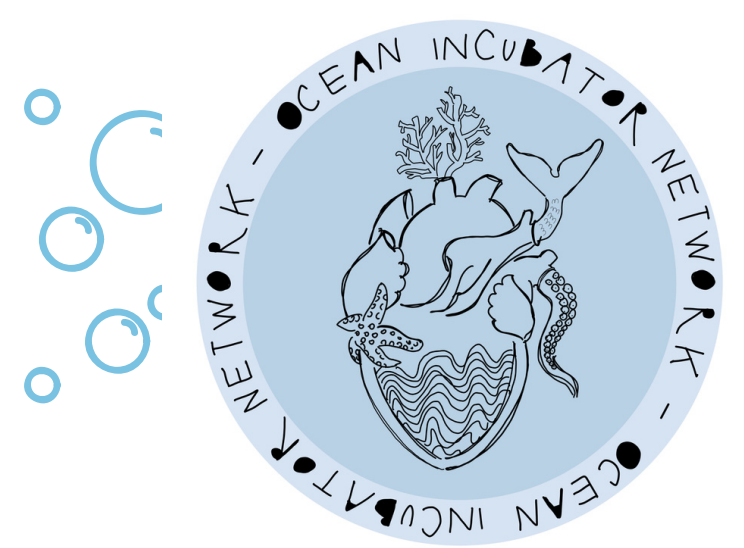
