This ECO_CARE discipline explores contemporary debates in environmental law, water governance, rights of nature, and legal pluralism through the lens of relationality, with special attention to Indigenous perspectives and Global South experiences.

The course is designed as an international and interdisciplinary learning space within the framework of the ECO_CARE project and the Erasmus+ Programme. It combines theoretical reflection, methodological discussion, and student-led presentations, encouraging participants to critically engage with questions of law, ecology, care, and justice.

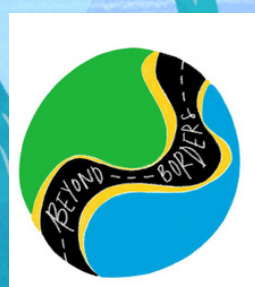
