- Students who require a Study Permit to enter Norway as an exchange student must apply for at least **30 ECTS credits** per semester.

☒ **You may apply for up to 60 ECTS in this form.** We recommend selecting additional courses as backup options. The additional courses you add will serve as backup alternatives if you are not admitted to your preferred courses or if timetable conflicts arise after arriving in Norway.
